

## Day Guests Momentum 2009

---

The Day Guest option to attend Momentum is primarily made available for individuals who are not familiar with the conference to have an opportunity to experience what it is like – with the hopes that in the following year, they would consider to attend the entire week. In addition, parents of students who are attending conference, often wish to visit their son/daughter during the week.

Monday and Saturday only include a single Main Session – held in the evening. Tuesday thru Friday typically includes two main sessions, a Morning Main Session and an Evening Main Session. Main Sessions are when the entire conference is gathered together for worship, and challenge from the Word from a speaker.

### Admittance to Main Sessions

---

1. The initial Main Session you choose to attend is FREE. (However, you still need to register. See details below.)
2. Admittance to any number of Main Sessions after attending your initial first session will include the following costs:
  - Adults: \$25/session
  - Students: \$25/session
3. Please note that Momentum does not allow any children (infant – 6<sup>th</sup> grade/under 13 years of age) admittance into any of the main sessions.
4. Payment is due at the time of registering. Payment may be made by check, cash, or credit card.

### How to Register

---

There is no pre-conference registration required. All guests visiting campus (regardless of attending a free session or any no-cost events) are required to register at the Momentum Office as soon as they arrive on campus.

A campus map with directions to the Momentum office, including a phone number, will be posted on the momentum website, [www.buildmomentum.org](http://www.buildmomentum.org), in June.

Once registered, guests will receive their admittance tickets.

Guests need to register a day at a time. Each day a guest arrives on campus, they must first go to the Momentum Office to register.

## Admittance to Other Programming During the Week

---

- **Programming with Additional Admittance Costs**

1. **Generations Lunch /Training Meetings** – a ticket of \$10/person will need to be purchased by 9 a.m. of the day you wish to attend. Tickets may be purchased at the Momentum Office. The fee covers the meal and the training. Lunch meetings are held Tuesday – Friday.
2. **Parent's Seminar** – Saturday, July 17 (10 a.m. – 3 p.m.) You must register in advance of conference. Registration details and a full description of the seminar will be posted at a later date at [www.buildmomentum.com](http://www.buildmomentum.com).
3. **CollegeLeader Seminar** – Friday, July 16 (9 a.m. – 1 p.m.) You must register in advance of conference. Registration details and a full description of the seminar will be posted at a later date at [www.buildmomentum.com](http://www.buildmomentum.com).

- **Programming with NO Additional Admittance Costs**

**Non-Main Session Schedules throughout the day** are FREE to attend at no cost. However, you still need to register at the Momentum Office as soon as you arrive on campus for liability purposes. These schedules include opportunities such as training seminars (apart from the ones listed in #1, 2 and 3 above), Bible Quizzing, NAC (Nurturing Abilities for Christ) and more. ## Meals and Lodging for all Schedules Listed Above

---

**MEALS** are not included. Day Guests may purchase meals on a meal-to meal basis at the campus dining hall. The prices for the buffet-style (all-you can-eat) meals are: \$5.95/breakfast; \$8/lunch; \$9.65/dinner. Day Guests are responsible to purchase their own meals through the university desk at the entrance to the dining hall.

**Lodging** is not included. Adults or students visiting Momentum are not permitted to stay overnight in the dorm with any registered Momentum attendee.
