



2025 YOUTH CONFERENCE DAY GUEST POLICY

We welcome Day Guests to visit the Momentum Youth Conference!

We encourage students and leaders who would like to visit to see what it is like in the hope that they might register for the entire conference the following year. Additionally, parents visiting their students and other guests who would like to hear certain speakers in the main session are also welcome!

At Momentum Youth Conference, Day Guest passes are only for admittance to the Main Sessions. Day Guests are not eligible to attend the Power Track student seminars, Youth Worker Labs, or to participate in any afternoon student activities, including off-campus ministry projects or on-campus student competitive events.

LODGING

Lodging on campus is NOT available for anyone not registered for the full week of Momentum Youth Conference. Visiting adults or students are not permitted to stay overnight in dorms with registered attendees (i.e., youth pastors/workers are unable to grant permission for guests from their church to stay in the dorm with their registered students/adults). This is not a space issue (empty beds available, willing to sleep on the floor, etc.); it is a liability issue.

REGISTRATION

Online Day Guest registration is available and can be found through the "Register" button on our website. Guests are also welcome to register once they arrive on campus at the Day Guest Booth, located in the lobby of the Chapel (where Main Sessions take place).

Payment is due either at the time of online registration or at check-in in the Chapel, beginning 30 minutes prior to the start of each main session. Payment may be made at Guest Check-In by check, cash, credit card, or online with advanced registration.

ADMITTANCE TO MAIN SESSIONS

Admittance to Momentum Main Sessions is \$20 per session for adults and students 12 years old and older, and \$10 per session for children aged 6 years old to those who have completed 6th grade PRIOR to the conference. Infants to 5 years old are free.

Day Guest seating is only available in the balcony and not on the main floor.

CHILDREN

Children must be supervised at all times. If adult guests have children younger than those who are permitted to attend the conference, they will need to be seated in the designated area for families with children. Children are not permitted to be seated on the main floor or in other areas of the balcony.

A live-feed room is available directly outside this balcony area. Parents are expected to take restless children there to continue viewing the session.

MEALS ON CAMPUS

Tickets for meals in the dining hall can be purchased from the Momentum Youth Conference Office/Help Desk.

AGES 3–12

- Breakfast: 7:30 am – 9:00 am: \$5.25
- Lunch: 12:15 pm – 2:00 pm: \$6.25
- Dinner: 5:00 pm – 7:00 pm: \$7.75
- Children ages 2 and under are free per IWU campus policy.

AGES 13 and Over

- Breakfast: 7:30 am – 9:00 am: \$7.75
- Lunch: 12:15 pm – 2:00 pm: \$8.75
- Dinner: 5:00 pm – 7:00 pm: \$9.75
- Note: Ages and prices are set by the campus dining service.
