



# MOMENTUM YOUTH CONFERENCE PRICING

## Deposit

A minimum \$75 deposit is due at the time of registering to reserve your space. (Deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable.)

## WHAT'S INCLUDED IN THE PRICE:

### Housing

- Housing is provided starting Tuesday night through Saturday night. Everyone is responsible for bringing their own linens, pillows, blankets, and towels. Momentum participants are housed by gender in university dorms and are chaperoned by their local church's youth workers.
- All dorm rooms will be set up to accommodate at least two individuals with a bunk bed. Because of space, some rooms will house three individuals, with the university providing an additional bed frame/mattress. In addition, individuals paying the deposit after **June 15** may need to be prepared to be added as a third person in a room and provided an air mattress from the university if no bed frames/mattresses remain available in the group's assigned block of rooms.
- Lead contacts will be notified in advance of arriving on campus of their group's housing arrangements. The university follows all liability guidelines for the number of people assigned to any given dorm room.

### Food

- Meals (lunch and dinner) are included in the price of Momentum, starting with Tuesday dinner and ending with Saturday dinner. Meals are buffet-style with several options. Snacks may be purchased at the Momentum Store as well as at university snack shops.

### Programming

- All programming, including main sessions, training tracks, and breakout groups, is part of the Momentum registration.

## WHAT'S NOT INCLUDED IN THE PRICE (BUT AVAILABLE AT ADDITIONAL COST)

### Breakfast

- Breakfast is not included in the registration fee but can be purchased for the week. The optional breakfast plan is \$32 (five full-menu breakfasts, Wednesday–Sunday in the dining commons). (Breakfast is included in the youth worker registration fee and crew staff fee.)

### Early Housing

- If your group is arriving on campus one day before the start of Momentum, Monday evening housing is optional and is an additional fee per registrant. Pre-conference meals are available at additional fees.
  - Tuesday breakfast \$6
  - Tuesday dinner \$7
- Early housing costs \$27 and can be purchased as part of registration.

### Transportation

If your group chooses to use Momentum Transportation for any off-campus ministry experiences, each participant must be prepared to pay a \$4 fee at check-in (through their lead contact). See the FAQ page (PDF) for further details.

#### Infants–4 Year Olds

A \$45 registration fee (\$60 after June 15) will be charged for each child and is to be paid upon registration. Children registered for the week who are 2 and under eat free in the IWU cafeteria, per IWU policy. Lunch and dinner for children ages 3–4 are covered with the registration fee. A breakfast plan for 3–4-year-olds can be purchased separately for \$27.

#### 5-Year-Olds through students who have completed 6th Grade *PRIOR* to conference

**\$195** – Register January 1–June 15

**\$210** – Register June 16–July 15

Fee includes lunch and dinner. Child's breakfast can be purchased for \$27.

#### Registration After July 1

- Dorm housing assignments are based on the number of registrations received as of July 1. Deposits paid after this date may result in being added within the previously reserved block of rooms for their youth group, as the IWU liability team allows.
- If extra beds are not available in your group's initial block of rooms, there is no guarantee that additional rooms can be added. The university has a limited supply of air mattresses, which would need to be placed on the floor, allowing a third person to be lodged in a room. Lead contacts will be notified in advance of these housing arrangements.
