



Registration Pricing Momentum 2020 (UPDATED 4.10.20)

A minimum \$200 deposit is due at the time of registering to reserve your space. (Deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable, unless Momentum is cancelled and then all but \$25 will be refunded).

- Certain restrictions apply for any consideration of a refund or transfer of funds.
- See the Pricing Chart on the next page for prices. Prices are based on the payment date of the initial \$200 deposit. Outstanding balances after July 1 incur additional fees.

Adult/Student Ratio Requirement — 1 female youth worker for every 1-12 female students; 1 male youth worker for every 1-12 male students. (An additional adult is needed for every 1-12 students above this initial ratio). Note that “youth worker” is defined as an adult staying in the dorm with the students.

What's included in the Price:

- **Housing:** Housing is provided starting Tuesday night through Saturday night. Everyone is responsible to bring their own linens, pillows, blankets, and towel. Momentum participants are housed by gender in university dorms and are chaperoned by their local church's youth workers. This year's campus has dorms that are suite style dorms with the majority having attached restrooms/showers.
- All dorm rooms will be set-up to accommodate at least two individuals with a bunk bed. Because of space, some rooms will house three individuals, with the university providing an additional bed frame/mattress. In addition, individuals paying the deposit after June 15 may need to be prepared to be added as a third person in a room and provided an air mattress from the university if no bed frames/mattresses remain available in the group's assigned block of rooms. Lead contacts will be notified in advance of arriving on campus of their group's housing arrangements. **The University will follow all CDC guidelines as well as IWU liability guidelines for the number of people assigned to any given dorm room.**
- **Food:** Meals (lunch and dinner) included in the price of Momentum start with Tuesday dinner and end with Saturday dinner. Meals are buffet-style with several options. Snacks may be purchased at university snack shops.
- **Programming:** All programming, including main sessions, training tracks, and breakout groups, are part of the Momentum registration.

What's NOT Included in the price, but available at additional costs:

- **Breakfast** is not included in the initial registration fee but can be purchased for the week
Breakfast Plan: \$26 (five full menu breakfasts, Wed. – Sun., in the dining commons)
Note: Breakfast is included in the youth worker registration fee (and volunteer staff fee) and is served at Staff Breakfast Meetings.
- **Early housing** (Monday evening) **and pre-conference meals** (Monday breakfast and/or Monday lunch) are available at additional fees. Early housing costs \$26 and can be purchased as a part of registration. The church's Lead Contact can purchase pre-conference meals on their Lead Contact Dashboard.
- **Transportation:** If your group chooses to use Momentum Transportation for any off campus ministry experiences, each participant must be prepared to pay a \$4 fee at check-in (through their Lead Contact). See the FAQ Page (PDF) for further details.

<p>Day Guest Rates for Adults and Students – See “Day Guest Policy” at buildmomentum.org under forms. Admission fee only includes main sessions. Day Guests are not permitted to stay overnight in any dorm. This is not a space issue (empty bed available, willing to sleep on the floor). It is a liability issue. Meals can be purchased as you go.</p>			
<p>Children (infant through 5th grade) and Child Caregiver: see policy and prices at buildmomentum.org under Forms. Note: Registration only includes lodging and the meals of lunch and dinner. Breakfast can be purchased separately. Children and Child Caregivers are not admitted into Main Sessions, training tracks, youth worker labs, or Staff Meetings. A Video Live –Feed Room is available to view Main Sessions.</p>			

Please Note: July 1st is the last date to place any checks in the mail. After this date, either pay online or simply bring your payment with you to present during check-in at Momentum. However, be prepared that bringing payment with you will increase the length of time to go through the line.

++ Paying Deposits after June 15: Dorm housing assignments are based on the number of registrations received as of June 15. Deposits paid after this date will need to be prepared to be added within the previously reserved block of rooms for their youth group - as the CDC guidelines and IWU Liability Team allows. In other words, if extra beds are not available in the initial block of rooms for your group, there is no guarantee that additional rooms can be added. The university has a limited supply of extra mattresses and bed frames (as well as air mattresses that would need to be placed on the floor) allowing a third person to be lodged in a room. Lead contacts will be notified in advance of arriving on campus of these housing arrangements.
