Week 5: Your Design

Discussion Overview: Over the past couple of weeks, we have been talking about how God has uniquely designed you for a specific purpose. We have looked at our spiritual gifts, passions, talents, experiences, and personalities and this week we want to put it all together to see how God has uniquely designed you and called you.

Digging Deeper

- After filling out the design profile, have students discuss their unique giftedness and calling.
- Has God clarified anything about who you are or what He wants you to do through this process?
- You as students are not the church of the future, you are the church now. How can you use everything that God has given you to serve the church and to honor God?
- If you are still unsure about what you are passionate about or where God is calling you, that is ok! But don't be idle. Try new things and be open to where God wants to lead you. He will direct your path and if you pursue God's heart, He will reveal Himself to you.

*If students don't use the design profile, have them write down their 3 highest and 3 lowest spiritual gifts, their personality test results, and the top 5 most impactful experiences in their life so far. Seeing the full picture of how God has designed them written down is helpful in processing how God wants to use them and where He is leading them.
