- What does it say about God and his character?
 - That God is worth being in chains for (v.13)
- What does this passage say about people?
 - People knew that Paul was in chains because of the Gospel (v.13)
 - Brothers and Sisters (Christians) became confident in the Lord and shared their faith. (v.14)
 - Some people teach about Jesus out of envy or rivalry (v. 15)
 - Some people use Jesus for selfish reasons (v.17)
- How does this passage point us to redemption(Jesus)?
 - $\circ~$ Jesus, and the gospel, is so worth it that Paul was willing to be in jail.
 - That must mean that Jesus was really important to Paul

 - God saves us (v.28)

 - We should stand in unity (v.27)
 - Don't be scared by those that try and scare you (v.28)
 - Christians will probably suffer for Jesus (v. 29)
- How does this passage point us to redemption(Jesus)?
 - Our conduct matters to Jesus
