Human Scrabble

Before Playing:

Come up with several words or phrases that may be central to the topic of the night and print out the words in VERY LARGE font, one letter per page. Make sure to have 2 sets of each word/phrase.

How to Play:

Get volunteers to make up two teams, one for each letter of your word/phrase. Hand each of them in random order a letter. Don't allow them to look until you say go.

The first team to correctly spell the word/phrase, so that your audience can read it, wins.

Twist:

For round two, have the second word/phrase build off the first word/phrase. Make sure that the players in round two are shorted the correct letter and have them figure out how to make their word intersecting the word from round one.
