- always do what is honorable

- Are you willing to share your struggles with someone else?
- Are you someone that other can go to?

2) 1 Samuel 20:4

- Are you willing to help?
- James 2:16

3) 1 Samuel 20:15, 2 Samuel 21:7

- Be thankful for your friends and show them kindness in return
- Don't just be a user

4) 1 Samuel 20:30-33

- Jonathan was willing to sacrifice for his friend
- He surrendered his chance to be king and also risked his life
