## Ephesians 6 (part 1)

Ephesians 5:21 -submit to each other -consider others not just yourself

-wives respect your husbands -husbands love your wives

For this lesson -what does submission look like for a child/parent -for a employee and boss

Ephesians 6:1-3 -unless your parents are telling you to do something illegal or sinful you should obey -beyond just obeying, honor them, show them respect \*kid speaking back to their mom \*my struggle in this area \*value your parents and time with them

Ephesians 6:4 -parents are not to abuse their authority -this gives children some leeway -if a parent is telling you to do something that is not right, you don't have to obey -if a parent is being unreasonable you can speak to them about it \*be cautious -you still must honor your parent -seek advise from a Godly adult you trust before taking action

-they are to train their children to follow Jesus

\*if you have Godly parents, trust their advise even if it doesn't make sense right now \*if you don't have Godly parents, find some Godly adults that can mentor you

Ephesians 6:3 -why is family so important? -if we have strong families it will help both us and our community have better lives
