If Jesus is better and I don't have to work to cover my sins, then what now?

10:22

First, we have faith in Jesus sacrifice

-we draw near, cast ourselves on him

*not just believing but actually totally relying on him for our salvation

*stool analogy

10:23

when we exercise faith, we can then have hope

-there is a hope of eternity in heaven (2 Cor 4:17)

-there is a hope that we can do something valuable right now

10:24

when we exercise faith and look toward God's hope

-we love and do good works for others

-caring for others and serving them

10:32-34

-love is hard so we need to be building up and drawing on faith and hope

Thankfully we don't have to do this alone

-We can look to examples of faithful people in the past (chapter 11)

-We have each other (10:24-25)
