5:1-4

- chosen for the position by God
- act on behalf of men to make them right before God and connect them to God
- priest also cared for the spiritual needs of the people and could have compassion on the people because they are weak humans too
- \*care for the people and connect them to God

What does this passage tell us about Jesus? Why does this make him a great high priest?  
(4:14-16, 5:5-10)

- has passed through the heavens
- he is a God who is near not far off
- tempted, yet without sin
- he understands and can relate with our sin struggle
- appointed by God
- he is humble not self seeking
- priest like Melchizedek (Genesis 14)
- king and priest
- has the power to help us
- offered prayers and was heard
- He knows what it is to cry out to God
- He knows how important it is to be heard
- learned obedience through suffering
- he knows how hard it is for us to follow God
- the source of eternal salvation
- priests offered a temporary reprieve from the wrath of God
- Jesus offers full and complete removal of the wrath of God

Jesus is caring, compassion, and empathetic but also king, ruler and powerful to help in time of need.
