Hebrews 9-10

What does God want from us?

10:5-7

- -He doesn't want sacrifices
- *The sacrifice has always been a means not an end

What is the purpose of sacrifices?

9:22

- -purification and forgiveness of sin
- -the price of sin is death
- *the point of a sacrifice is so humans can be cleansed of sin and brought into relationship with God
- -OT sacrifices did this imperfectly (10:11)
- -Jesus sacrifice did this perfectly, once and for all (10:12-14)
- *painting a rust spot on a car
- -What God really wants is us in committed relationship with him
- *God doesn't want us to do a bunch of stuff for him. He just wants us to love him and be with him.
- -When we are with him. We praise him because we see how awesome he is
- -When we are with him. We serve because we want other to experience how awesome he is
- -If you did a bunch of stuff for someone but never actually talked to them
- -If you said you are dating someone but never actually spent any time with them
- *this means I need to be doing things that help me know God more
- -read the Bible and go to church to learn who God is
- -pray so I can pour myself out to God
- -help others so they can know how awesome God is and so we can see God at work
