



## Mark 6

- good follow up to Mark 3
- see the disciples progress and struggles
- much like our life as disciples

-In Mark 3, we were challenged to be disciples and make disciples

Mark 6:7-11

- Jesus sends out his twelve disciples to go start the work he's been preparing them for
- the disciples were not fully trained at this point
- one of the excuses we use not to serve is that we don't know enough or have enough experience
- \*don't use inexperience as an excuse not to serve

Mark 6:12-13

- they have great success
- this is why we serve, so we can see God do something awesome

Serving isn't always amazing success stories, some times it's hard

Mark 6:30-44

- put yourself in the shoes of the disciples
- they had to be tired and worn out
- \*even when I'm worn out and am I stilling seeing people with compassion

ver 35-37

- They tell Jesus to send the crowd to get food
- Jesus tells them to feed the crowd
- \*another excuse we use not serve is that the problem is too big for us to make a difference

ver 38-44

- Jesus took the little they had and did something great with it
- \*when we entrust our effort to God, he will do more than we think

2 Corinthians 12:9-10

when you're not fully trained, go and serve and God will do great things  
when you're weak and don't feel like you have much to offer, go and serve and God will do great things
