Mark 7

Something that I've been thinking a lot about

Mark 7:1-8

- -The Pharisees had a lot of traditions
- -In striving to follow the rules of the Old Testament they created a bunch of addition rules
- -Has anyone tried to read Leviticus before?
- *They became more about following rules than following God

Mark 7:18-23

- -It's not about what goes in but what is coming out
- -It's not about following or not following rules, it's about where your heart is
- -What they were doing wasn't bad stuff but they had missed the point of why they were doing it
- *You can do the right thing in the wrong way
- *Jesus is more interested in your heart and motivation than your action
- **Christmas Present Example
- *How often are we like that first example with Jesus?

Mark 14:3-9

- -Mary anoints Jesus with costly oil (a year wages)
- -Some of the disciples, especially Judas, are upset because the money wasn't given to the poor
- *I would have probably been in the group telling Jesus this was wasteful
- *It's not about being efficient and doing the most stuff, it's about loving and worshiping Jesus
- *This is the proper motive
- *It's not always about doing good things, but about how we can best worship Jesus

Why are you doing things you're doing?

Is your heart and motivation right?

*Joann's excitement

How do we get there?

- -Mary spent time with Jesus and saw her brother raised from the dead
- -Nurture our relationship with Jesus and continue to learn and experience how great he is
