Intro:

- Has there ever been a time in your life where you extremely confident about something?
 - Example 1: Coffman game senior year
 - 4-0 feeling good
 - Example 2: School- test, competition, drivers test, etc

Questions:

- Read 1 Jn 2:3-11
 - Asked the first question, I have heard a lot: How do I know my faith is real? How do I know I am saved?
 - I know I have struggled with this
 - V. 3- Know Him=Saved
 - Know Him=Keeping His commands/His word- v. 5
 - We can be confident of knowing God because we want to keep/follow His word!
 - V. 9-11- Do you walk in the light? Or in the Darkness?
 - Gal. 5:
 - 19-21- Darkness
 - 22-25- Light- Keeping in step with the Spirit
