# By Design | Fall of Man

#### Intro:

- What is a childhood toy or item you used to always play with? Or, what is something you always used to do, no longer do?
  - o In a sense, you all have been separated from those things
  - o The idea of separation is what we are going to talk about tonight

### **Pray**

- Read Gen. 3:1-7
  - O DQ- Go back and read Gen. 2:16-17, and then read Gen. 3:3-5. Did Adam and Eve really die when they ate of the fruit? Who was the honest side in this situation: God or the serpent?
    - Thought they may not have died physically, did they die another way?
    - I am anticipating that this question will be difficult for students to fully give an answer. Be pushy for conversation here to see what you can get out of students.

## **Teaching**

- Go back to v. 4- they ate of the fruit yet, they didn't die...
  - o Did they die another way?
  - o Eph 2:1-3
- Last week about being physical and spiritual beings- being made in the image of God

#### **Next Question**

- Read Gen. 3:8-13
  - O DQ- Read Gen. 1:28-31 and then read Gen. 3:10 and 11. See how God talks to man in both situations. Contrast these two interactions. Why was there a difference? What happened?
  - God talks to man directly in Gen. 1, but in Gen. 3, there is a disconnect, there is a separation. This separation has occurred because of sin entering the world.
  - o Read Isaiah 59:2
  - o DQ- What does this mean for us today?

## **Extra time Question:**

- After reading v. 14-19 how did God curse the serpent, woman and man?
  - o Serpent
    - Cursed above all livestock, on the belly forever, eat dust
    - Enmity (active hostility) between the serpent and the woman/her offspring
  - Woman
    - Pain in childbearing
    - Wanting to lead over male leadership
  - o Man
    - Ground is cursed
    - Pain to take care of it
    - Shall return to ground one day
- Only Jesus could break the curse from sin!

## **Big Takeaway**

- We are spiritually dead people and this makes us separated from a Holy God
  - o In the beginning, God said it was very good- perfect
  - Because we are physical and spiritual beings, we are spiritually dead because of the presence of sin
- Only way back to a holy God is to become spiritually alive!
  - o Read Eph 2:4-10
