Intro Question: When people care for you, when do you feel most cared for?

- This connects to our main point of God caring for His people

Setting Context - Read

- Exodus 1:5-7
 - o Jacob/Israel's descendants in Egypt from Joseph bringing them there
- 1:8 New king came to power
- Read Exodus 1:9-14
 - o Egyptians sought to break the Israelites but the Israelites kept going
- Pharaoh commanded midwives to kill Hebrew boy babies
 - o Read Exodus 1:18-22
- Ch. 2 Context
 - o Moses' mother had him
 - o At 3 months old she put him in the Nile river
 - o Pharaoh's daughter saw him
 - o Moses' sister saw him
- Read Exodus 2:8-9

DQs [Discussion Questions]

- What instances do you see God care for His people?
 - o 1:20- taking care of the midwives and Israelites
 - 2:8-9- Providing a way for Moses to be taken care of by his mother
 - o 2:23-25- Listening to the groans of His people
- What characteristics of God are revealed through this story?
 - His goodness
 - Taking care of midwives
 - His provision
 - Moses' mother to take care of him

 - o Read over these verses to focus your prayer time
 - O John 13:34-35: "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."
