

DEUCES | Exodus 12 | Teaching

Intro:

- Welcome to 144!
- We are continuing our Deuces series
- Main Idea for tonight: God shows His care for His people through providing salvation

Discovery Activity:

- Read your section of Exodus 12, and record what God commanded to Israelites
 - MS- 12:1-11
 - FS- 12:12-17
 - JS- 12:18-28

Teaching:

- This story is about the final plague of judgement upon Egypt
- God is commanding the Israelites to be prepared for their exit from Egypt.
 - He is also commanding them to remember what God has done for them
- We see these same things being remembered in a Passover Seder
 - Seder- In Hebrew means order/procedure.
 - Different aspects of a Seder in order to remember what God did to provide salvation for His people to get out of Egypt.
- Seder Plate
 - Biblical components
 - Roasted bone-
 - The blood of a lamb protects them from the angel of death
 - Matzah bread
 - Could not wait for their bread to rise, leaving in haste
 - Bitter herbs- horseradish
 - Reminder of the bitter life they had in Egypt
 - Nonbiblical components
 - Parsley into salt water

- Initial blessing while in Egypt, but that became bitter with salt water
 - Salt water symbolizes the tears shed with Exodus.
- Haroset- apples and nuts
 - Symbolize the mortar used in Egypt
- Roasted egg
 - Reminder of special Passover sacrifice at the temple
 - New life post exodus

Final Punch:

- Main point: God shows His care for His people through providing salvation
- We see God provides salvation for the Israelites by providing a way to leave Egypt.
- What is another time that we have seen God provide salvation for people? – Jesus
 - Direct correlation between blood of lamb and blood of Jesus
- God and His judgement passed over houses with blood of lamb
- God and His judgement will Passover us with blood of Jesus
- This is the Gospel; this is our hope.
- God has provided a salvation plan for us! This is Jesus!
