

DEUCES | Exodus 5-11 | Teaching Notes

Deuces Series:

- Series main idea: God shows His care for His people
- Series verse: Exodus 2:23-24

Main Idea: God shows His care for His people by using His power

Context:

- Ch. 5
 - Moses goes to Pharaoh to ask to let the nation of Israel go into the wilderness to have a feast for God
 - Pharaoh gave them harder work
 - V. 9
 - Israelites get mad at Moses
 - Moses gets mad at God
- Ch. 6
 - God promises deliverance
 - Moses questions again
 - God charges them
 - V. 13
- Ch. 7
 - Read v. 1-6
 - Proving themselves to Pharaoh
 - V. 10-13

Activity: 5 minutes

- Take 3 plagues
 - Learn about them
- Divided among pods
 - MS- 1-3

- FS- 4-6
- JS- 7-10
- Get to know them quickly and then recap what is their significance

Teaching:

- Main Idea tonight: God shows his care for His people through His power
- One of the questions asked was do you think these plagues have anything to do with the Egyptian culture- it does!
- Actually, each of the plagues is a direct attack onto the gods of Egypt
 - Slide show
- MI: God shows His care for His people through His power!
- God is bringing plagues onto Egypt and it reveals His power!
 - He shows He cares by providing a way out of the land of Egypt
 - Eventually pharaoh, exhausted by the plagues, lets the Israelites go
- Care= Plan
- Power= over Egyptians/His people's enemies

DQs [Discussion Questions]:
