

Pricing 2025

Deposit:

A minimum \$75 deposit is due at the time of registering to reserve your space. (Deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable.)

What's included in the Price:

• **Housing:** Housing is provided starting Tuesday night through Saturday night. Everyone is responsible for bringing their own linens, pillows, blankets, and towels. Momentum participants are housed by gender in university dorms and are chaperoned by their local church's youth workers.

All dorm rooms will be set up to accommodate at least two individuals with a bunk bed. Because of space, some rooms will house three individuals, with the university providing an additional bed frame/mattress. In addition, individuals paying the deposit after June 15 may need to be prepared to be added as a third person in a room and provided an air mattress from the university if no bed frames/mattresses remain available in the group's assigned block of rooms. Lead contacts will be notified in advance of arriving on campus of their group's housing arrangements. The university follows all CDC guidelines as well as IWU liability guidelines for the number of people assigned to any given dorm room.

- Food: Meals (lunch and dinner) are included in the price of Momentum starting with Tuesday dinner and ending with Saturday dinner. Meals are buffet-style with several options. Snacks may be purchased at the Momentum Store as well as at university snack shops.
- **Programming:** All programming, including main sessions, training tracks, and breakout groups, are part of the Momentum registration.

What's NOT included in the price, but available at additional costs:

- Breakfast: Breakfast is not included in the registration fee but can be purchased for the week. The
 optional Breakfast Plan is \$32 (five full menu breakfasts, Wed. Sun., in the dining commons). Breakfast
 is included in the youth worker registration fee (and volunteer staff fee) and is served at Staff Breakfast
 Meetings.
- Early Housing: If your group is arriving on campus one day before the start of Momentum, Monday evening housing is optional, an additional fee per registrant. Pre-conference meals (Tuesday breakfast and/or Tuesday lunch) are available at additional fees. Early housing costs \$27 and can be purchased as a part of registration.
- Transportation: If your group chooses to use Momentum Transportation for any off-campus ministry experiences, each participant must be prepared to pay a \$4 fee at check-in (through their Lead Contact). See the FAQ Page (PDF) for further details.

STUDENT

For students who have completed 7th -12th grade prior to conference. Breakfast is not included in this price.

ADULT GUEST

For adults one year out of high school or older. Includes lunch and dinner and all main sessions. Adult Guests are responsible for their own lodging. \$32 breakfast plan available in registration.

YOUTH WORKER

Only for adults who are housed in the dorm with their own students. Includes breakfast at daily staff meetings.

\$405 - Register January 1 - June 15

\$480 - Register June 16 – July 15

VOLUNTEER

For individuals out of high school one year and older. Includes all meals and lodging in staff dorms (separate from youth group/student housing).

Volunteers are accepted by application, and they register for a reduced cost because of their participation in volunteer responsibilities.

Infants - 4-year-olds: a \$45 (\$60 after June 15, 2025) registration fee will be charged for each child, to be paid upon registration. Children registered for the week who are 4 and under eat free in the IWU cafeteria by IWU policy.

5-year-olds through 6th-grade students: a \$195 (\$210 after June 15, 2025) registration fee is charged for each child, to be paid upon registration. This fee includes lunch and dinner; a child's breakfast plan can be purchased separately for \$25.

Registrations After July 1:

Dorm housing assignments are based on the number of registrations received as of July 1. Deposits paid after this date will need to be prepared to be added within the previously reserved block of rooms for their youth group as the IWU liability team allows. If extra beds are not available in your group's initial block of rooms, there is no guarantee that additional rooms can be added. The university has a limited supply of extra mattresses and bed frames (as well as air mattresses that would need to be placed on the floor) allowing a third person to be lodged in a room. Lead contacts will be notified in advance of arriving on campus of these housing arrangements.
