



PRICING

DEPOSIT:

A minimum \$75 deposit is due at the time of registering to reserve your space. (Deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable.)

WHATS INCLUDED IN THE PRICE:

- **Housing:**
 - Housing is provided starting Tuesday night through Saturday night. Everyone is responsible for bringing their own linens, pillows, blankets and towels. Momentum participants are housed by gender in university dorms and are chaperoned by their local church's youth workers.
 - Indiana Wesleyan provides dorms with suites (two rooms sharing a bathroom).
 - All dorm rooms will be set up to accommodate at least two individuals – with two twin beds. A few dorms have three twin beds in rooms. Everyone is responsible to bring their own linens, pillows, blankets, and towels.
 - The Momentum Housing Team will assign youth groups a block of rooms in a dorm based on their group's total registration numbers when bed capacity is reached. Momentum has the right to block rooms at its discretion.
 - Room blocking will be done to minimize having unoccupied beds while providing rooms that only have individuals from the same youth group.
 - The Momentum Office will send the Lead Contact a housing worksheet, listing the block of rooms assigned to their youth group. The Lead Contact person has the freedom to choose how to assign both their adults and students to the individual rooms. The completed worksheet is only needed to be submitted at check-in. Students and Adults may not be assigned to the same room unless they are son/father or mother/daughter.
 - Dorm housing assignments are based on the number of registrations when bed capacity is reached. Deposits paid after this date will need to be prepared to be added within the previously reserved block of rooms for their youth group as the IWU liability team allows. If extra beds are not available in the initial block of rooms for your group, there is no guarantee that additional rooms or air mattresses can be added. The University has a limited supply of extra mattresses and air mattresses that would need to be placed on the floor allowing additional people to be lodged in a room. Lead contacts will be notified in advance of arriving on campus of these housing arrangements.
- **Food:**
 - meals (lunch and dinner) are included in the price of Momentum starting with Tuesday dinner and ending with Saturday dinner. Meals are buffet-style with several options. Snacks may be purchased at the Momentum Store as well as at university snack shops.
- **Programming**
 - all programming, including main sessions, training tracks, and breakout groups are part of the Momentum registration.

WHATS NOT INCLUDED IN THE PRICE, BUT AVAILABLE AT ADDITIONAL COSTS:

- **Breakfast:** Breakfast is not included in the registration fee but can be purchased for the week. The optional breakfast plan is **\$32** (five full menu breakfasts, Wednesday-Sunday in the dining commons). (*Breakfast is included in the youth worker registration fee and crew staff fee.*)
- **Early housing:** If your group is arriving on campus one day before the start of momentum, Monday evening housing is optional and is an additional fee per registrant. Pre-conference meals (Tuesday breakfast and/or Tuesday lunch are available at additional fees. Early housing costs **\$35** and can be purchased as a part of registration.
- **Transportation:** If your group chooses to use Momentum Transportation for any off-campus ministry experiences, each participant must be prepared to pay a **\$4** fee at check in (through their lead contact. **See the FAQ page (pdf) for further details.**
 - **Complementary airport shuttles available for groups choosing to fly.**

CHILD AND CAREGIVERS:

Infants- 4 year olds: \$70 (\$85 after May 15) registration fee will be charged for each child to be paid upon registration. Children registered for the week who are 2 and under eat free in the IWU cafeteria by IWU policy. Lunch and dinner for children 3-4 year olds are covered with the registration fee. A child's breakfast plan for 3-4 year olds for the week can be purchased separately for **\$27**.

5 year olds through 6th grade students: \$220 (\$235 after May 15) registration fee is charged for each child, paid upon registration. Fee includes lunch and dinner. Child's breakfast can be purchased for **\$27**.
